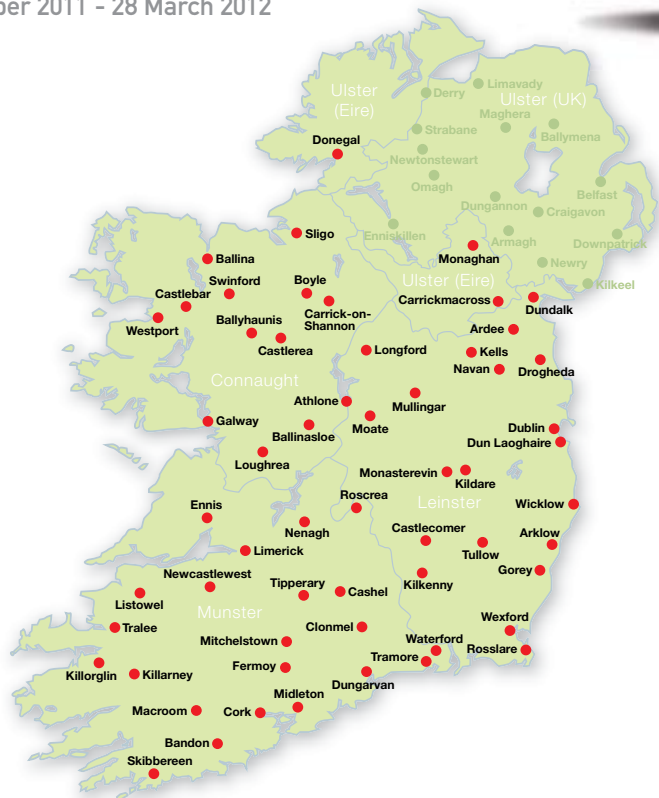

Each customer has a free luggage allowance of two medium sized suitcases stored securely in the hold.

Travelling with



Coaches depart from Victoria Coach Station, London, close to Victoria Underground and bus stations.

Check-in

Customers must check in at the Eurolines check-in desk next to Gate 19. Check-in opens one hour before departure (30 minutes before when departing from other parts of the UK) and closes 15 minutes before. You should have your passport and travel documentation with you for inspection.

Luggage

Customers must label their luggage with the labels provided, and they will then be put on the coach by the Coach driver. They will also unload the luggage when you arrive at your destination.

Sea crossing

Sea crossings will be made by Ferry. When crossing, you will be required to get off the coach and pass through border control on either side.

Refreshments stops

Refreshment stops will be made during your journey, and Ferry services also provide shopping, food and other facilities.

Safety

Seatbelts should be worn at all times during the journey. All coaches operated by Eurolines have a strict no-smoking policy.
