Cologne

Now the the fourth biggest city in Germany, Middle Age Cologne was one the most important cities in the Holy Roman Empire. In 1248 work began on its imposing cathedral. Known as the Dom, it was once the world's tallest building. It's still Germany's most visited attraction. Over the Christmas holidays the colourful and bustling Christmas markets use the Dom as a dramatic backdrop. Sightseeing in Cologne is concentrated around the Dom, with three major museums a stones throw away.

Frankfurt

Fourteen museums make up the longest mile of museums in Europe – the Museumsufer (Museum Embankment) on the southern bank of the Main. Sachsenhausen, the oldest district in Frankfurt, lies on the south side of the river, and is one of the traditional entertainment areas with bars, clubs and restaurants housed in traditional buildings. Visitors can climb up the 328 steps of Emperor's Cathedral tower for breathtaking views of Frankfurt.

Berlin

When it comes to fashion, art, design and music, the German capital is the city to watch. Bursting with an enviable list of attractions for visitors to enjoy including: museums, galleries, gourmet restaurants and even opera houses, Berlin caters for all tastes. Historic 20th century landmarks are all around you in Berlin, the Reichstag, Brandenburg Gate, Checkpoint Charlie and what's left of the Berlin Wall. It's not just the history that draws visitors here. The nightlife is an essential part of Berlin where the cafes and bars are vibrant meeting places for locals and tourists alike. You won't be disappointed spending time in this fascinating city.

Munich

Munich is the Capital of Bavaria and lies near the foot of the Alps. Germany's second most popular destination after Berlin, it has something to offer everyone, be it culture, hi-tech, parks and greenery, night-life, architecture, beer gardens, shopping or the skiing and sailing close by. Oktoberfest is one of the things that puts Munich on the map. Marienplatz, where the main pedestrianised streets converge, is the undisputed centre of Munich, and the location of the impressive town hall, the Neues Rathaus. Many of the city's main attractions are in the immediate vicinity, so sightseeing can easily be done on foot or by hopping on and off trams. The former artists' quarter is now considered the most fashionable part of the city, with numerous cafes, bars, restaurants and nightlife venues.

Vienna

The historic centre of Vienna is a UNESCO world heritage site, and is sometimes unfairly compared to an open-air museum. Vienna is also a dynamic young city, famous for its music scene, cult-status underground record stores, a vibrant Monday through Sunday club scene and a multitude of street performers. The people are friendly and willing to go out of their way or bend the rules a little if they feel they can do someone a favour. Vienna is also famous for its coffee culture. "Let's have a coffee" is a very commonly heard phrase.



Travelling with



Eurolines coach services to Europe depart from Victoria Coach Station in London which is located close to Victoria Underground and Bus stations.



Check-In

Customers need to check-in at the Eurolines check-in office located adjacent to Gate 19. Check in commences one hour before departure and closes 15 minutes before to enable all customers to board and to ensure a prompt departure. Customers should have their Passports and other travel documents ready for inspection at check-in. A boarding card for each customer and luggage labels will be issued and customers will be advised from which gate their coach will leave. Check in time at other UK departure points is 30 minutes before departure.

Luggage

Customers must label their luggage which will be loaded into the hold of the coach and will normally remain there until arrival at the destination or interchange point. The Coach driver will load and unload customers' luggage but customers are responsible for seeing their own luggage onto and off the coach on which they are travelling.

Sea crossings

Sea crossings are made by Ship or Eurotunnel, check timetables for specific information. On arrival at the ferry port or Eurotunnel terminal customers will be required to disembark from the coach and pass through both UK and destination country Border Control offices and show their Passports. Normally customers are not required to be accompanied by their luggage, however occasionally Border Control officials do require customers to take their own luggage with them.

Refreshment stops

Refreshment stops are taken periodically throughout the journey providing the opportunity for refreshment and shipping services used by Eurolines provide a range of shops, restaurants and other facilities.

Services returning to London arrive in Victoria Coach Station's Arrivals terminal, customers making onward coach connections will need to cross the street to the Departures terminal

All coaches operated by Eurolines have a strict no-smoking policy and seat belts should be worn at all times during the journey.
